DynMcDermott Petroleum Operations President and CEO Named a National Safety Council CEO Who “Gets It”

Robert McGough Noted for His Dedication to Employee Safety and Health

Robert McGough, President and CEO of DynMcDermott Petroleum Operations has been named by the National Safety Council to its 2010 list of CEOs Who “Get It.” These CEOs are recognized as leaders among corporate leaders who have made distinguished contributions to the safety and health of their employees, their employees’ families and their corporate communities. DynMcDermott is the management and operating contractor for the Department of Energy’s Strategic Petroleum Reserve.

Since 2003, the National Safety Council has recognized chief executive officers who understand the significance of safety to their operations and corporate sustainability. CEOs Who “Get It” also realize that engaging employees in a company culture of safety builds a strong network of people who care about one another and their performance on the job.

“When leaders value safety, engage with employees and implement best practices, they are able to produce successful and profitable workplaces,” said Janet Froetscher, NSC president and CEO. “The National Safety Council is proud to recognize these leaders. All eight individuals have shown a commitment to protect employees and their families both on and off-the-job. Each recipient has a unique and dedicated approach to safety management.”

Headquartered in New Orleans, DynMcDermott has held the SPR contract since 1993. The contract was recently extended until 2013. DynMcDermott operates four Government-owned crude oil storage sites: 1) Bayou Choctaw located in Iberville Parish southwest of Baton Rouge, 2) West Hackberry, located near Lake Charles, 3) Big Hill, near Winnie, Texas, and 4) Bryan Mound, near Freeport, Texas. Together, these sites have the capability to store over 700 million barrels of crude oil in underground salt domes. The crude oil is available for draw down upon direction of the President of the United States in the event of a severe energy supply disruption. DynMcDermott is the recipient of the 2005 Malcolm Baldrige National Quality Award for performance excellence and the 2006 Robert Campbell Award for safety and health in addition to numerous other awards for performance excellence.

Mr. McGough retired from the U.S. Army as a Colonel in 1989 after serving in numerous command and staff positions revolving around petroleum logistics. He became President and CEO of DynMcDermott in January 2001.

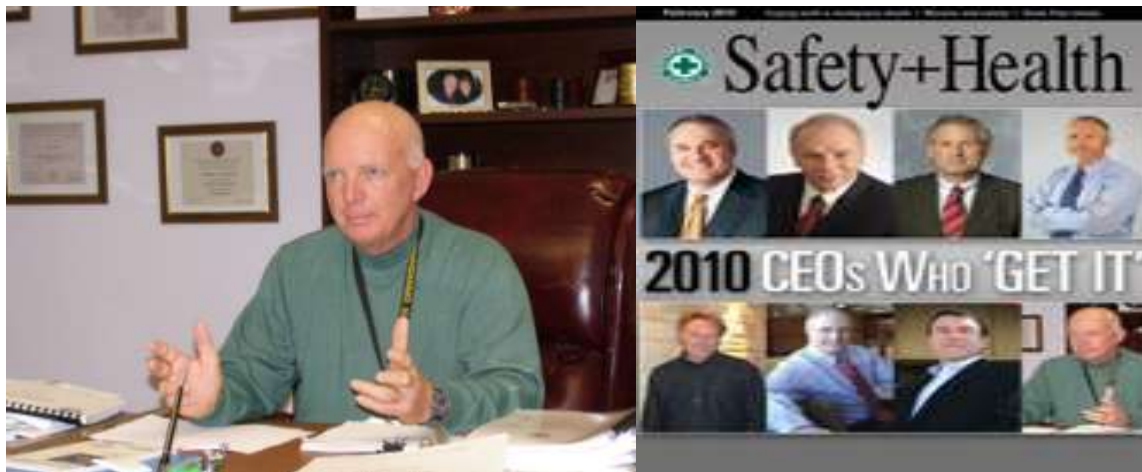
